

Excellent X-Rays – Purple Activity Sheet 1: Make an X-Ray Tablet

Resources

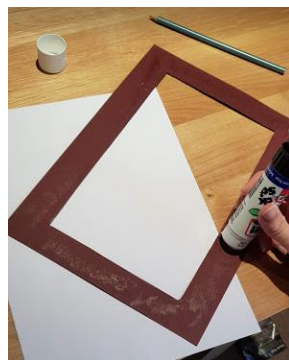
- 2 pieces of card or cardboard (the sides of a cereal box work well)
- A ruler or something you can use to draw straight lines
- Scissors
- A pencil
- Glue or sticky tape
- 3 x blank A4 paper
- Pencils/pens to decorate your frame (optional)

Instructions

1. Draw a frame shape on your pieces of card using a ruler/straight edge and cut the inside out – try and make them the same size (ask for an adult's help). You can decorate it if you want to.



2. Draw some pictures (maybe bones) or write a message on one piece of paper (this will be your hidden 'x-ray')
3. You now need to hide your x-ray by sticking one piece of paper on top of it and one onto the back (a bit like making a paper sandwich with 'x-ray' piece of paper as the filling)
4. Glue your cardboard frames on either side of the stuck together paper sandwich – your 'x-ray' should now be completely invisible



**But hold it up to a window
on a sunny day and watch
your x-ray magically appear!**
