## Extra activity: Silhouette (Shadow) Drawings



Normal stamps feature a side view of the Queen or a 'profile' drawing. You can create your own profile drawings of people or things using shadows.

## **Resources**

- Blank paper
- Torch or sunlight
- A pencil
- A person or a toy to be your model

## **Instructions**

- 1. Set up your artist studio outside On a sunny day find a place outside and place a toy on a piece of plain white paper
- 2. Draw around the shadow created by the toy using your pencil (hint: you might need to hold it with your other hand to get a good shadow)
- **3.** If you want, you can colour it in or add things like eyes, nose, mouth etc.



## OR

- Set up your artist studio inside Stick a piece of plain paper on the wall using easy to remove blue tac or sticky tape (ask permission first!)
- **2.** Ask your model to sit on a chair sideways in front of it or to hold up a toy there
- **3.** Using a torch try to get the person's shadow on the paper and then draw around it
- **4.** If you want you can colour it in or add things like eyes, nose, mouth etc.
